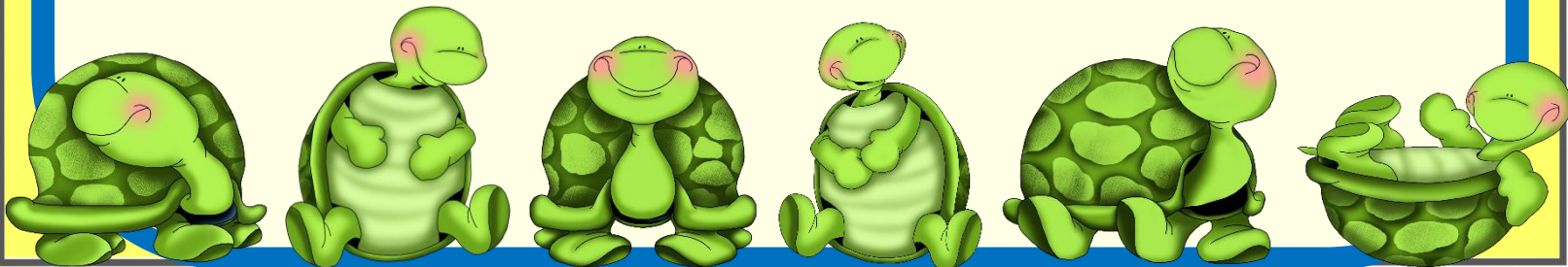
# Will you help flip the turtle?

## Included Materials & Directions:

63 Situation Cards  
3 Blank Card Templates

Print and Laminate.  
Cut to Separate.

Place cards face down on table. One at a time, students pick a card. Depending on grade level, 1/the student reads the scenario out loud and then answers the "how would you help" questions.





## Here's how I use this:

**Step #1:** I show students one of these YouTube clips\* that show turtles flipping over other turtles who are stuck on their backs.

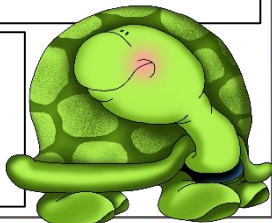
**Step #2:** I explain to students that just like the turtle in the videos, we all need a helping hand once in a while. These turtles helped out their friends in their time of need, they flipped the turtle. Would you do the same? How can you “flip the turtle” in your life? How could you help someone in need?

**Step #3:** I play the game! Place face down on table. One at a time, students pick a card, read the scenario out loud and answers the question.



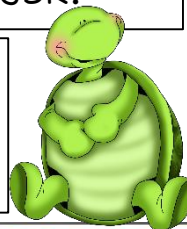

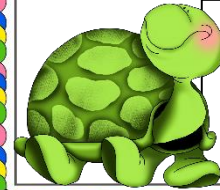

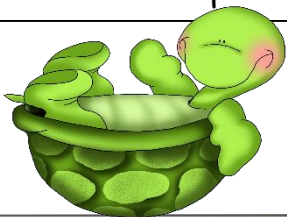
